## Job description

Our systems are deployed worldwide at wastewater treatment plants, pumping stations, and in the waste processing industry. Since 1998 we have completed more than 1000 such installations, with a strong focus on the Middle East region.

As Lead Project Engineer you are the key figure in the full realization of our international projects. You combine leading a team with an active, hands-on role in engineering. From our head office in Gentbrugge you manage the process from initial design through to final delivery.

- You are a natural team leader: you know how to motivate people, divide tasks, and follow up on them.
- You work analytically, in a structured way, and independently, even when several projects are running simultaneously.
- You are customer- and result-oriented, and communicate clearly and professionally, including in international contexts.
- You express yourself fluently in Dutch and English, both verbally and in writing – this is a strict requirement.
- Willingness to travel abroad (project-related, limited in duration).
